RESPONSE TO ACTION FROM ENVIRONMENTAL PROGRAM COUNCIL MEETING ON MAY 24, 2016, REGARDING COMPLIANCE WITH U.S. DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY ORDER 435.1 FOR A NEW ONSITE DISPOSAL FACILITY

The purpose of this letter is to close out an action, regarding the path forward on how the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) intends to proceed with meeting DOE Order (O) 435.1 requirements from the Environmental Program Council meeting held on May 24, 2016.

The approach for DOE O 435.1 compliance for the proposed onsite disposal cell known as the Environmental Management Disposal Facility (EMDF) differs from the approach used for the existing onsite disposal cell which is referred to as the Environmental Management Waste Management Facility. DOE O 435.1 allows for Comprehensive Environmental Response. Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) sites to comply by demonstrating how the substantive requirements are met through the CERCLA process, and this approach was utilized for the Environmental Management Waste Management Facility.

For EMDF, this letter serves as my commitment to submit all of the documents normally used for non-CERCLA sites as part of the DOE O 435.1 process. This will assist in ensuring that the review performed by the DOE Low-Level Waste Disposal Facility Federal Review Group of DOE O 435.1 compliance remains independent of the CERCLA process. DOE will pursue

DOE O 435.1 approval of EMDF in parallel with the CERCLA process in order to obtain the Disposal Authorization Statement authorizing final design and construction of the facility prior to signing the Record of Decision for EMDF.

In addition, DOE is committed to providing opportunities for the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) to participate throughout the DOE O 435.1 process, including participation as observers in the DOE Low-Level Waste Disposal Facility Federal Review Group reviews leading to the Disposal Authorization Statement. DOE will ensure that opportunities to attend DOE Low-Level Waste Disposal Facility Federal Review Group training sessions and webinars are provided and will share the technical basis documents used for DOE O 435.1 compliance. As discussed during the Environmental Program Council meeting, the purpose of participating as observers is to maintain awareness of the process, etc.; EPA and TDEC will not have decision making authority.
