Dear Camden Citizens –

- Inspections of synthetic cover continued.
- Monitoring of gas collection system continued.
- Continued to remove leachate from industrial waste and aluminum processing waste cells, placed in temporary storage while awaiting results of analytical data.
- Continued to perform perimeter ammonia monitoring.
- Changed locks on groundwater monitoring wells.
- Continued to haul leachate for off-site disposal (Friday only, not over the weekend).

I'm going to start sending out updates once or twice a week rather than daily since there is much less activity going on at the site and the daily reports are going to sound repetitive. For this week, we expect to continue to do most of the items above; we also plan on placing clay on top of the landfill to promote better stormwater runoff and to reduce stormwater infiltration. This should significantly reduce the amount of leachate that we have to manage.
