Below is a summary of items that have occurred at EWS from Saturday 6/24 through Friday 6/30. My previous update covered the period through Friday 6/23.

Pat.

- Continued to ship Aluminum Processing Waste Cell leachate off-site for disposal
- Continued to treat Industrial Waste Cell leachate
- Performed routine daily gas system and cover operation and maintenance activities
- Repaired erosion from stormwater on the Aluminum Waste Processing Cell
- Repaired, regraded, and reseeded small erosional area on Industrial Waste Cell
- Performed daily ammonia monitoring
- A sprinkler system on the Industrial Waste Cell was partially installed and is functioning
- Continuing site clean-up and housekeeping activities
- The first EWS bankruptcy auction event was completed
 - Trucks and trailers that have been sold are starting to leave the site
 - o Remaining items sold at first auction expected to be removed from site over the next week
 - o Second auction event (for heavy equipment) is in the planning stages
- Development of closure design ongoing
