Below is a summary of items that have occurred at EWS from Saturday 10/7 through Friday 10/13. My previous update covered the period through Friday 10/6.

Pat.

- Continued to ship Aluminum Processing Waste Cell leachate off-site for disposal
- Shipped Industrial Waste Cell leachate off-site for disposal
- Treated Industrial Waste Cell leachate to prepare for off-site disposal
- Performed routine daily gas system and cover operation and maintenance activities
- Performed daily ammonia monitoring
- Continuing site clean-up and housekeeping activities
- Placed additional clay on temporary Aluminum Processing Waste cell cover to repair areas with small desiccation cracks
- Began engineering work on the Industrial Waste Cell closure design

As a reminder, a special announcement was issued on October 9th informing citizens that due to the unavailability of geomembrane, cap construction will be delayed until the spring.
