Dear Camden Citizens –

Below is a summary of items that have occurred at EWS from Saturday 1-20-2018 through Friday 1-26-2018. My previous update covered the period through Friday 1-19-2018.

Pat.

- Continued to ship Aluminum Processing Waste Cell leachate off-site for disposal
- Industrial Waste Cell leachate continued to be treated; previously treated and stored leachate was sent off-site for disposal
- Performed routine daily gas system and cover operation and maintenance activities
- As noted previously, the telemeter on the Red Barn ammonia monitor has malfunctioned. The unit has been removed and sent off for repair; a loaner unit has been installed and is collecting data while the unit is being repaired.
- Performed daily ammonia monitoring
- Continuing site clean-up and housekeeping activities
- Repairs were made to the Aluminum Process Waste Cell leachate pump and piping system
- Design package management and bid schedule is unchanged from the previous update. Recent activities and current milestone dates are:
 - Design Package Release: January 5, 2018 (Completed)
 - Mandatory Contractor Site Meeting Was Held on January 19, 2018 (Completed)
 - Notice to Successful Bidder: February 28, 2018
 - Expected Closure Construction Mobilization: April 6, 2018
 - Expected Closure Construction Completion: August 31, 2018
