Below is a summary of items that have occurred at EWS from Saturday 2-3-2018 through Friday 2-9-2018. My previous update covered the period through Friday 2-2-2018.

Pat.

- Continued to ship Aluminum Processing Waste Cell leachate off-site for disposal
- Industrial Waste Cell leachate continued to be treated and stored
- Performed routine daily gas system and cover operation and maintenance activities
- The Red Barn ammonia monitor is still out being repaired; the loaner unit remains in place and is collecting data
- Performed daily ammonia monitoring
- Continuing site clean-up and housekeeping activities
- Performed monthly calibration of the portable ammonia monitor and both stationary ammonia monitors
- Design package management and bid schedule is unchanged from the previous update. Recent activities and current milestone dates are:
  - Design Package Release: January 5, 2018 (Completed)
  - Mandatory Contractor Site Meeting Was Held on January 19, 2018 (Completed)
  - Notice to Successful Bidder: February 28, 2018
  - Expected Closure Construction Mobilization: April 6, 2018
  - Expected Closure Construction Completion: August 31, 2018
