- Continued to ship Aluminum Processing Waste Cell leachate off-site for disposal
- Industrial Waste Cell leachate continued to be treated and stored
- Performed routine daily gas system and cover operation and maintenance activities
- Performed monthly calibration of the portable and both stationary ammonia monitors
- Performed daily ammonia monitoring
- Closure Construction Activities Performed:
 - Continued clearing and grubbing borrow area
 - o Placed structural fill on top of landfill over installed gas management piping
 - Continued gas management system installation work on Aluminum Processing Waste Cell (approximately 95% complete, one line remaining)
 - Placement of select soil over geomembrane liner extension is complete
 - o Continued placing structural fill over select soil to achieve required sideslopes
 - Main stormwater pond has been completely drained and pond modification work is ongoing (approximately 95% complete)
 - Weekly construction meeting held
