- Continued to ship Aluminum Processing Waste Cell leachate off-site for disposal
- Industrial Waste Cell leachate continued to be treated and stored
- Performed routine daily gas system and cover operation and maintenance activities
- Performed daily ammonia monitoring
- Performed monthly calibration on both stationary ammonia monitors and one portable ammonia monitors
- Closure Construction Activities Performed:
 - Activities at Aluminum Processing Waste Cell:
 - Continued placement of select (rock and organic free) soil above grade-certified sections of structural fill (approximately 90% complete)
 - Continued clearing and shaping storm water ditches
 - Continued fill removal and shaping activities in the soil borrow area
 - Performed installation of stormwater control components (ditch check dams, energy dissipaters)
 - Continued removal of existing vegetation layer on Industrial Waste Cell
 - Contractor continued to expose base liner tie-in areas on Industrial Waste Cell
 - Weekly construction meeting held
