- Continued to ship Aluminum Processing Waste Cell leachate off-site for disposal.
- Industrial Waste Cell leachate continued to be treated, stored, and sent off-site for disposal.
- Performed routine daily gas system operation and maintenance activities.
- Performed daily ammonia monitoring.
- Closure Construction Activities Performed:
  - Activities at Aluminum Processing Waste Cell:
    - Contractor continuing placement of vegetative layer, placement approximately 70% complete.
    - Contractor installing stormwater channels and energy dissipators
    - Contractor continued preparing base grade surface for Closure Turf installation.
    - Contractor continued cleaning Closure Turf tie-in areas in preparation for Closure Turf installation.
  - Activities at Industrial Waste Cell:
    - Contractor began hauling clay for compacted soil liner (soil liner still 85% complete) and stockpiling for future use.
    - Contractor maintained exposed clay during reporting period.
