Below is a summary of items that have occurred at EWS from Saturday 5-4-2019 through Friday 5-10-2019. My previous update covered the period through Friday 5-3-2019. Thank you.

Pat.

- No Aluminum Processing Waste Cell leachate was shipped off-site for disposal.
- Industrial Waste Cell leachate continued to be treated and stored prior to sending off-site for disposal.
- Performed routine daily gas system operation and maintenance activities.
- Performed daily ammonia monitoring.
- Performed monthly calibration on two stationary and one portable ammonia monitors
- Closure Construction Activities Performed:
 - Activities at Aluminum Processing Waste Cell:
 - Geomembrane installation contractor completed placement of Closure-Turf synthetic turf elements above geomembrane.
 - Contractor completed placement of sand infill on new Closure-Turf areas (next week, sand infill will be placed as-needed on existing Closure-Turf).
 - Contractor completed construction of stormwater down-chutes and gabion basket energy dissipaters.
 - Contractor began installation of Hydrobinder (storm water channel protection) on Closure Turf storm water channels (approximately 60% complete).
 - Contractor continued to install vegetative layer (approximately 90% complete).
 - Activities at Industrial Waste Cell:
 - No significant work performed during this period.
 - General Site Construction Activities:
 - Contractor continued to remove haul road between the Aluminum Processing Waste Cell and the Industrial Waste Cell (this is necessary to complete the storm water drainage channel between the cells).
 - Contractor completed screening borrow material for Industrial Waste Cell protective cover.
 - Fence contractor continued installation of perimeter fencing (approximately 30% complete).
