The county shall advertise the event and include the following required information.

- The DATE; the LOCATION; and the HOURS of OPERATION;
- Acknowledgement that costs are paid by the TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND CONSERVATION;
- A list of **excluded** items: MEDICAL and INFECTIOUS WASTES (EXCEPT NEEDLES AND SHARPS IN PUNCTURE-PROOF CONTAINERS), AMMUNITION and EXPLOSIVES, RADIOACTIVE WASTES, INCLUDING SMOKE DETECTORS, and ANY EMPTY CONTAINERS.
- Very Small Quantity Generator Waste (i.e. wastes from non-household sources such as businesses, schools, farms, churches, etc.) is acceptable by appointment only. Call 615-643-3170 to request a price quote and schedule an appointment.
- Instructions on how residents are to recycle/dispose of paint and electronics.

Site Set Up

The site may be accessed at _____ on the morning of the event.

A solid waste receptacle will be available for the contractor's use and have a capacity of _____ yds. There should be a contingency plan if the receptacle is filled.

A county representative will be on site for the duration of the collection event and provide volunteers to direct traffic and gather survey information. They should arrive a minimum of 30 minutes prior to the start time of the event for a safety briefing.
