

**HAZARDOUS WASTE POST-CLOSURE PLAN ISSUED
WITH CORRECTIVE ACTION FOR TEKNOR APEX TENNESSEE COMPANY
OF BROWNSVILLE**

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM) has issued a hazardous waste management post-closure with corrective action plan to Teknor Apex Tennessee Company of Brownsville. The facility (EPA ID TND054876834) is located in Haywood County at 751 North Dupree Street, Brownsville, Tennessee 38012. This decision follows a 45-day public comment period on the draft plan that ended on November 2, 2020. A [Response to Comments](#) has been issued which reflects that no comments were received during the comment period from the public. No hearing was requested by the public.

The plan (TNHW-183) allows Teknor Apex Tennessee Company to perform post closure and corrective action for the site, including providing site security, performing groundwater monitoring and maintaining institutional controls, such as restrictions on digging and use of groundwater. The plan includes requirements to investigate any other release of hazardous waste or hazardous constituents discovered at the site, regardless of the time at which waste was placed in a unit, and to take appropriate corrective action for any such release. At this time, there is one unit, AOC-A, Landfarm Area that requires Interim Measures.

Teknor Apex has not previously been issued a hazardous waste post-closure plan. Teknor Apex is performing detection monitoring and maintenance of a hazardous waste landfill. Teknor Apex will continue to monitor and maintain the post-closure unit under the newly issued plan.

The present status for all solid waste management units, except one, is for no further action. AOC-A, was used to landfarm soil contaminated with di(2-ethylhexyl)phthalate. Teknor Apex Tennessee Company is required to complete corrective action of AOC-A.

The plan is issued under the authority of the Tennessee Hazardous Waste Management Act of 1977, as amended, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-212-101 et seq., and Rule Chapter 0400-12-01, Hazardous Waste Management. The plan is effective as of November 20, 2020, and shall remain in effect until November 20, 2030, unless continued, revoked and reissued, or terminated under applicable regulations.
