## NOTICE OF INTENT TO MODIFY A HAZARDOUS WASTE PERMIT FOR BEFESA ZINC US

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM) proposes to modify Hazardous Waste Management Permit TNHW-177 as requested by Befesa Zinc US (Befesa). Befesa (EPA ID TND982144099), is located in Roane County at 199 Truck Route, Rockwood, TN 37856. TDEC invites the public to submit comments on this proposal during a 45-day comment period ending on **Monday, May 1, 2023.** 

The Class 3 Modification will add three additional rail tracks and increase storage capacity in the railcar storage area from a maximum of 38 railcars to 110 railcars, for a total storage capacity of 21,346 cubic yards from the current 7,372 cubic yards. Changes to the site Integrated Contingency Plan, Container Management Plan, and Closure Plan have been updated to reflect changes within the permit as part of this modification.

The permit is proposed to be modified under the authority of the Tennessee Hazardous Waste Management Act of 1977, as amended, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-212-101 et seq., and Rule Chapter 0400-12-01, <u>Hazardous Waste Management</u>. In accordance with Rule 0400-12-01-.07(9)(c)5.(iii)(VII) and -.07(7)(e), DSWM is providing a 45-day comment period beginning on the date of this publication.

A public hearing will be held on Monday, April 17, 2023, at the Rockwood Community Center located at 710 N Chamberlain Avenue, Rockwood, TN 37854, as well as via video teleconference. Information on how to join online is provided below. From 5:30 to 6:00 p.m. EDT, an informational session will be held. The public may inspect and discuss the permit modification application and the draft permit modification with the DSWM and with representatives of the applicant. There will also be an opportunity for comments to be recorded or written and submitted during this time. The formal hearing will begin at 6:00 p.m. First, DSWM will explain its tentative decision to issue the permit modification. Then the applicant's representative will describe the proposed facility modification. DSWM will then receive oral comments on the draft permit from the public.

After considering all comments, DSWM will make a final decision to either issue or deny the permit modification. Notice will be given to the applicant and to each person who has submitted written comments or requested notice of the final decision. At the time of the final decision, a Response to Comment document addressing all significant input received on the proposed modification will be made available to the public. The final decision shall become effective upon signing by the Director of DSWM.
