

HAZARDOUS WASTE MANAGEMENT PERMIT REISSUED TO TRADEBE TREATMENT AND RECYCLING OF TENNESSEE, LLC

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation's (TDEC) Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM) has reissued a hazardous waste permit to Tradebe Treatment and Recycling of Tennessee, LLC (Tradebe). Tradebe (EPA ID No. TND000772186) is located on Victory Lane in Millington, Shelby County, Tennessee, 38053. This action follows a 45-day public comment period, which ended on September 21, 2022. No comments were received from the public during the formal comment period.

The permit allows Tradebe to store hazardous waste at the facility with a maximum storage quantity of 788,322 gallons at the facility at any one time. This allows for the maximum storage of 703,772 gallons in containers and 84,550 gallons in tanks. The permit allows the facility to treat a maximum quantity of 937,536 gallons per day. This allows for the maximum treatment capacity of 735,000 gallons per day in containers and 202,536 gallons per day in tanks. The conditions of the permit require that any future and existing SWMUs or AOCs be evaluated for potential releases and remediation, as necessary. The conditions require notification of imminent hazards and, when applicable, compliance with the requirements developed under land disposal restrictions and organic emission standards.

The permit is issued under Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-212-101 et seq., and Tennessee Rule Chapter 0400-12-01, Hazardous Waste Management. The permit is effective as of September 27, 2022, and shall remain in effect until September 27, 2032, unless continued, revoked and reissued, or terminated under applicable regulations.
