SUBJECT: Notification of Class I Permit Modification to Permit, *Fort Campbell, Clarksville, Tennessee, Hazardous Waste Permit TNHW-173, Corrective Action September 29, 2017, TN5210020140*

To Whom It May Concern:

Because you have requested to be kept informed of changes to the subject permit, U.S. Army Garrison Fort Campbell is providing the required notice for a Class I modification to its existing permit.

Fort Campbell has replaced a damaged monitoring well 149AMW006 with a new monitoring well 149AMW006R. Fort Campbell coordinated with the State of Tennessee to complete a permit modification with the following changes to the permit:

- a. Figure 4.5-10 Site Map was modified to add the new monitoring well 149AMW006R, and to show monitoring well 149AMW006 as abandoned.
- b. Monitoring well 149AMW006R construction data was added to Table 5.1-1, Tennessee Monitoring Well Locations and Construction Details.
- c. The location coordinates for monitoring well 149AMW006R were added to Table 5.1-2, Well Coordinates.
- d. Monitoring well 149AMW006R was added to Table 5.1-3 Groundwater Monitoring Schedule and Analytical Information. Monitoring well 149AMW006 was removed.

These necessary changes continue to protect health and the environment and have been approved the State of Tennessee as a Class I Permit modification effective 11 January 2021.
