

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING ON THE REQUEST TO MODIFY A
HAZARDOUS WASTE MANAGEMENT PERMIT FOR AMERICAN ZINC RECYCLING CORP.

American Zinc Recycling Corp. is requesting a modification to the hazardous waste management permit, TNHW-177. American Zinc Recycling Corp. (EPA ID TND982144099) is located at 199 Truck Route, Rockwood, TN 37854. The Class 3 Modification will modify the permit to add three additional rail tracks and increase storage capacity in the railcar storage area from a maximum of 38 railcars to 110 railcars, for a total storage capacity of 21,346 cubic yards from the current 7,372 cubic yards.

A public meeting is scheduled for 4:00 pm to 5:00 pm, on Wednesday, June 30, 2021, at the Rockwood Community Center, 710 N Chamberlain, Rockwood, TN. This meeting will be hosted by representatives from American Zinc Recycling Corp. The purpose of this meeting is to inform the community of the proposed changes and to facilitate meaningful input.
