

NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD ON THE REQUEST TO MODIFY  
HAZARDOUS WASTE MANAGEMENT PERMIT TNHW-197  
FOR EXCEL TSD OF TENNESSEE, LLC

Excel TSD of Tennessee, LLC (ETSD) is requesting a modification to Hazardous Waste Management Permit TNHW-197 for a change in the ownership and operational control in accordance with Tennessee Rule 0400-12-01-.07(9)(b)3 (9b3 Transfer). ETSD (EPA Identification No. TND980847024) is located at 550 Rivergate Road, Shelby County, Memphis, Tennessee 38109. The change in ownership and operational control in accordance with a 9b3 Transfer will modify the ownership and operational control, specifically to transfer ownership of ETSD from a member-managed company to Amlon Interco LLC (Amlon), which will own 100 percent of the membership interest in ETSD. The request to transfer the ownership and operational control in accordance with the requirements of a 9b3 Transfer was received on December 2, 2025. Amlon intends to continue operating the ETSD facility in accordance with the Permit requirements and conditions. Permit TNHW-197 authorizes the storage and treatment of hazardous wastes in containers and aboveground storage tanks – no disposal or incineration of any hazardous or non-hazardous waste has ever been authorized or performed at this facility.

In accordance with Rule 0400-12-01-.07(9)(b)3.(ii)(I), this notice is the announcement of a 30-day comment period, beginning with the day of publication, February 24, 2026, and ending on March 26, 2026. Comments must be submitted to the Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM) contact person by 4:30 p.m. CST on March 26, 2026, to ensure consideration.

Based on the DSWM review of the Permit Transfer request and the public comments received, the TDEC Commissioner will make a final determination to either approve or, for cause, reject the Permit Transfer and notify ETSD of such determination.
