

NOTICE OF FINAL DECISION
ISSUANCE OF CLASS 2 PERMIT MODIFICATION TO
FORMER AGC GREENLAND PLANT

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM) has issued a Class 2 Permit Modification to the Former AGC Greenland Plant (AGC) facility. AGC (EPA ID TND037909348) is located at 600 Cardinal Way Rd., Church Hill, Tennessee 37642. This decision follows a 60-day Public Notice comment period, which ended April 6, 2025. In addition to the 60-day Public Notice comment period, AGC held a Public Meeting on March 13, 2025, at the Volunteer High School Library in Church Hill, TN. Comments were received and were addressed in a Response to Comments.

The Class 2 Permit Modification included the implementation of an In-Situ Chemical Oxidation injection program as part of the Final Remedy for the Hazardous Waste Disposal Unit (HWDU). Corrective action conditions for the Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) and Areas of Concern (AOC) are retained as part of the permit. The conditions of the permit require that any future and existing SWMUs or AOCs be evaluated for potential releases and remediation, as necessary. The conditions require notification of imminent hazards, and when applicable, compliance with the requirements developed under land disposal restrictions and organic emission standards.

The Class 2 Permit Modification is issued under the authority of the Tennessee Hazardous Waste Management Act of 1977, as amended, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-212-101 et seq., and Rule Chapter 0400-12-01, Hazardous Waste Management. The permit modification is effective as of March 13, 2026, and shall remain in effect until September 14, 2026, unless continued, revoked and reissued, or terminated under applicable regulations.
