Olin Corporation will conduct a pre-application community public meeting at the Cleveland Bradley County Public Library located at 795 Church St. NE, Cleveland, TN from 6:00 – 7:00pm on August 26, 2025, in the Community Room. This meeting is to present the Community Impact Statement and receive comments for a permit renewal that will be submitted to the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) as Olin transitions to post-closure care of TNHW-163.

Olin's Charleston Chlor-Alkali Plant uses membrane cell technology to produce chlorine, sodium hydroxide, potassium hydroxide and hydrogen. Additional products produced on site utilizing these chemicals are hydrochloric acid and sodium hypochlorite. Products are distributed via pipeline, railcar, tanker truck and barge. The expiring Hazardous Waste Landfill Operations Permit was issued by TDEC on September 15, 2015. The permit was valid for 10 years. The permit authorizes the continued operation of the Hazardous Waste Landfill. During this application cycle, Olin is closing the management unit with the intent to go to post-closure care of this waste management facility.

A summary of written and oral comments will be included in the permit renewal application materials for review and consideration by TDEC. Written and oral comments will be accepted at this community public meeting or may be submitted in written form no later than 4:00 p.m. on August 27, 2025 to the contact person for Olin Corporation Stacie Campbell-Eckhoff, P.
