

TDEC Rulemaking Hearing to be held July 11, 2023 – Lead-based Paint Abatement

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM) will hold a hearing on the proposed repeal Chapter 1200-01-18 Lead-based Paint Abatement, update the existing language, and transfer it to Chapter 0400-13-01. At the hearing, DSWM will present and receive comments on this proposal.

The hearing will be held in the Multimedia Room on the third floor of the Tennessee Tower, 312 Rosa L Parks Ave, Nashville TN 37243, on July 11, 2023, at 2:00 pm CST. The Department of Environment and Conservation is committed to the Tennessee Pledge and reopening responsibly.
