

## New Atlas Organics Tier II Composting Facility Approved

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC), Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM), has issued a new Tier II composting permit to Atlas Organics. The facility, identified as CMP330000013, is located in Hamilton County at 1045 E. 23<sup>rd</sup> Street, Chattanooga, Tennessee.

This permit authorizes construction, operation, and closure of a Tier Two composting facility for waste materials classified as yard waste, pre-consumer and post-consumer food waste, and/or certain wastes having similar characteristics and approved in writing by TDEC.

DSWM made the draft of this permit available for review during a 45-day public comment period which ended on January 4, 2023. DSWM received no oral or written comments during the above-mentioned public comment period.
