

**THE CHEMOURS COMPANY FC, LLC – EAST HOLLOW LANDFILL
EARLY CLOSURE PERMIT MODIFICATION –
COMMENTS WELCOME**

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC), Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM), has tentatively decided to issue a solid waste disposal facility permit major modification to The Chemours Company FC, LLC for their Class II Landfill, East Hollow. This major modification will result in a reduction in approved facility contours due to the execution of final closure prior to achieving previously approved final contours. This modification will result in the facility being permanently closed and placed into a post-closure care status.

The facility, identified as The Chemours Company FC, LLC – East Hollow Class II Landfill (IDL430000069), is located in Humphreys County at 1950 DuPont Road, New Johnsonville, TN (latitude 36.046279 N/longitude - 87.971966 W). This permit would allow closure construction, and post-closure care of the Class II disposal facility for non-hazardous industrial trash generated from the day-to-day plant operations, including paper waste, plastic, rubber, glass, leather, rags, non-salvageable scrap metal. No hazardous wastes, as regulated by the Tennessee Hazardous Waste Management Act (Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-212-101, et. seq.) and the Rules adopted pursuant to the Act are permitted for disposal at this facility. The official responsible for operation of the facility is Robert Vargas, 1950 DuPont Road P.O. Box 219, New Johnsonville, TN 37134 (931) 535-2111.

DSWM has made a preliminary determination that The Chemours Company's application meets the applicable requirements of Tennessee Rule Chapter 0400-11-01, Solid Waste Processing and Disposal. Pending consideration of any comments received during the 45-day comment period, DSWM intends to issue this permit modification.

DSWM invites the public to review and submit comments on this proposal anytime during the 45-day comment period ending on Monday, November 7, 2022. Comments must be received by 4:30 p.m. CDT on Monday, November 7, 2022 to assure consideration. A request for a public hearing must be in writing and state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing. If a hearing is scheduled, another notice will be published at least 15 days in advance.

After considering all public comments, DSWM will make a final decision to issue or deny the permit. DSWM will provide notice of the final permit decision and a Response to Comments addressing all significant input received on the draft permit to the applicant and to each person who has submitted written comments. These documents will also be available online and at the repositories listed above.
