

**TRANSFER OF LANDFILL OWNERSHIP APPROVED
FROM GFL ENVIRONMENTAL TO MORRISTOWN-HAMBLLEN COUNTY
SOLID WASTE COMMISSION**

Morristown-Hamblen County Solid Waste Commission has taken ownership of the Class III landfill at 3849 Sublett Road, Morristown, TN 37813 (latitude 36.16049/longitude -83.29420). The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation's (TDEC), Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM) approved a change of ownership for the Class III landfill, pursuant to Rule 0400-11-01-.02(6)(a) of Tennessee's Solid Waste Program Processing and Disposal Regulations. Morristown-Hamblen County Solid Waste Commission applied for a minor permit modification to transfer the permit for the Lakeway Sanitation & Recycling C&D (DML320000100) from the previous owner, Lakeway Sanitation & Recycling C&D, LLC. As part of this transfer of ownership, the facility name has changed from the Lakeway Sanitation & Recycling C&D Landfill to the Hamblen County-Morristown C&D Landfill. The operator has changed from GFL Environmental to Morristown-Hamblen County Solid Waste Commission. The final decision to issue the permit modification was made on Friday, February 16, 2024.
