

CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG LANDFILL PLANS LATERAL EXPANSION

The City of Lawrenceburg has applied to the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM) for a solid waste disposal facility permit modification to construct and operate a lateral expansion of the existing City of Lawrenceburg Class III Demolition Landfill (DML500000129). This permit modification proposes two additional units or phases (Units 3 & 4), located to the east of Units 1 & 2 originally permitted on March 31st, 2020. The facility is located in Lawrence County, at Grinnell Drive, Lawrenceburg, Tennessee (latitude 35.2054° N/longitude -87.3827° W). The waste materials to be accepted are classified as farming wastes, landscaping and land clearing wastes, construction/demolition, shredded automotive tires, and/or certain wastes having similar characteristics and approved in writing by TDEC.

Under State law, the applicant must obtain a modification of the existing permit before constructing or operating the proposed facility expansion. DSWM has received a Part I Permit Application indicating the City of Lawrenceburg's desire to obtain the required major permit modification. State law dictates Part I applications must be noticed to the public once complete

This notice only confirms the receipt of Part I, not the entire permit application. A complete permit application consists of both a Part I and a Part II, as described in Regulations Governing Solid Waste Processing and Disposal Facilities in Tennessee, Rule 0400-11-01-.02(3)(c). When the facility submits the complete Part II application, DSWM will do an in-depth review to determine if the application meets the technical standards of the Regulations described in Tennessee Rule 0400-11-01-.04(9), Solid Waste Processing and Disposal. Once the technical review is completed, DSWM will make a tentative decision to either grant or to deny the permit and will issue a public notice. This second notice will provide the public at least 45 days to submit written comments on the proposed action. If there is a significant degree of public interest, DSWM will schedule a public hearing and give at least 15 days' notice. (A public hearing may be announced in the second notice if DSWM is already aware of significant public interest.) After considering all comments received, the DSWM Director shall issue a final permit decision and a response to comments.
