## **New Putnam County Compost Facility Approved**

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC), Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM), has issued a solid waste compost facility permit for a new Putnam County Composting Facility. The facility, identified as CMP710000009, is located in Putnam County at 11089 Cookeville Boat Dock Road, Baxter, TN 38544.

This permit authorizes construction, operation, and closure of a new fully-permitted Tier II composting facility, resulting in 2.20 acres to be used for the composting of wastes classified as yard and food waste, including tree trimmings, brush, leaves and wood chips, hay and food wastes and/or certain wastes having similar characteristics and approved in writing by the Department.

DSWM made the draft of this permit available for review during a 45-day public comment period which ended December 2, 2019. DSWM received no oral or written comments during the above mentioned public comment period.
