

**TRANSFER OF LANDFILL OWNERSHIP APPROVED
FROM WHITE COUNTY TO WMWC, LLC**

WMWC, LLC has taken ownership of the Class I landfill and Class III landfill on Gum Springs Mountain Road, Sparta, TN 38583 (latitude 35.89303 N/longitude -85.581993 W). The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation's (TDEC), Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM), approved a change of ownership for the Class I and III landfills, pursuant to Rule 0400-11-01-.02(4)(i) of Tennessee's Solid Waste Program Processing and Disposal Regulations. WMWC, LLC applied for a minor permit modification to transfer the permit for the existing White County Class I Landfill (SNL930000136) and Class III Landfill (DML93000037) from the previous owner, White County. The facilities will continue to be named the White County Class I Landfill and the White County Class III Landfill. This transfer of ownership also reflects a change in operator from White County to WMWC, LLC. The final decision to issue the permit modification was made on Thursday, July 25, 2024.
