

TENNESSEE ALUMINUM PROCESSOR INC & SMELTER SERVICE CORPORATION PLANS INDUSTRIAL LANDFILL EXPANSION

The Tennessee Aluminum Processor Inc & Smelter Service Corporation has applied to the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM) for a permit modification to allow them to construct and operate an expansion to the existing TAP-SSC Landfill (IDL600000213). The facility is located in Maury County, at 7249 Hoover Mason Road, Mount Pleasant, TN 38474 (latitude 35.548889/longitude -87.173611). The waste materials to be accepted will not change and are classified as waste by-product from an industrial-secondary aluminum smelter process.

Under State law, the applicant must obtain a modification to the existing solid waste disposal facility permit before constructing or operating the proposed expansion. DSWM has received a Part I Permit Application indicating The Tennessee Aluminum Processor Inc & Smelter Service Corporation's desire to obtain the required major permit modification.

A complete permit application consists of both a Part I and a Part II, as described in Regulations Governing Solid Waste Processing and Disposal Facilities in Tennessee, Rule 0400-11-01-.02(3)(c). When the facility submits the complete Part II application, DSWM will do an in-depth review to determine if the application meets the technical standards of the Regulations described in Tennessee Rule 0400-11-01-.04(9), Solid Waste Processing and Disposal. Once the technical review is completed, DSWM will make a tentative decision to either grant or to deny the permit and will issue a public notice.

This second notice will provide the public at least 45 days to submit written comments on the proposed action. If there is a significant degree of public interest, DSWM will schedule a public hearing and give at least 15 days' notice. A public hearing may be announced in the second notice if DSWM is already aware of significant public interest. After considering all comments received, the DSWM Director shall issue a final permit decision and a response to comments.
