

## NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE MAJOR MODIFICATION TO OLIN BRINE SLUDGE PHASE IV CLASS II LANDFILL

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC), Division of Land Protection, Waste Management Branch (DLP-WMB), has tentatively decided to issue a solid waste disposal facility permit major modification to Olin Corporation for the Landfill Olin Brine Sludge Phase IV Class II Landfill (IDL060000041). The facility is located in Bradley County, at 1186 Old Lower River Road, Charleston, Tennessee (latitude 35.3023/longitude -84.7894).

This permit would allow construction, operation, closure, and post-closure care of the Class II disposal facility for the disposal of waste materials generated on-site at the Olin Plant and approved in writing by TDEC. No hazardous wastes, as regulated by the Tennessee Hazardous Waste Management Act (Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-212-101, et. seq.) and the Rules adopted pursuant to the Act, shall be accepted for disposal at this facility. The official responsible for the operation of the facility is Josh Spahn, Olin Corporation – Charleston Plant, 1186 Old Lower River Road, Charleston, TN 37310 (423) 336-4469.

DLP has made a preliminary determination that this proposal meets the applicable requirements of Tennessee Rule Chapter 0400-11-01, Solid Waste Processing and Disposal. Pending consideration of any comments received during the 45-day comment period ending on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, DLP intends to issue this permit modification.

DLP invites the public to review and submit comments on this proposal anytime during the 45-day comment period ending on Tuesday, November 3, 2026. Comments must be received by 4:30 p.m. CST on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, to ensure consideration. A request for a public hearing must be in writing and state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing. If a hearing is scheduled, another notice will be published at least 15 days in advance.

After considering all public comments, DLP will make a final decision to issue or deny the permit. DLP will provide notice of the final permit decision and a Response to Comments addressing all significant input received on the draft permit to the applicant and to each person who has submitted written comments. These documents will also be available online and at the repositories listed above.
