At this time, there are no online **Project Monitor Refresher** training courses approved. Project Monitor discipline training certificate expiration dates will be honored for six months past the current printed expiration date due to the lack of approved online training courses. This extension is only applicable for Project Monitor refresher training certificates and for those who are renewing existing certification/accreditation. Individuals who are seeking to gain initial accreditation in the asbestos program will still be required to submit valid, non-expired training certificates.

To utilize this temporary extension, Project Monitor applicants shall complete the application process, pay the required fee and submit a statement that they were not able to meet the training requirements of taking a TN approved on-line refresher course.

These temporary emergency accommodations will be in affect from March 20, 2020 until further notice. Emergency accommodations will be reassessed at the end of each month until further notice and these accommodations may be terminated at that time at the Department's discretion.
