Recently, Robert Martineau, Commissioner of the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation, welcomed our newest partners, Nissan Smyrna and Nissan Decherd, into the Tennessee Green Star Partnership.

During the ceremony, where both facilities

received their flags and certificates, Commissioner Martineau said, "It is my strong view that protecting the environment and promoting prosperity are not mutually exclusive. The true notion of balance comes when a cleaner, safer more sustainable environment goes hand in hand with economic prosperity and improved quality of life for the citizens of Tennessee."

One year ago this month, the Office of Sustainable Practices began this series of articles to highlight the unique accomplishments of our partners to fulfill the balance that Commissioner Martineau spoke of.

In 2016, the industry partners of the Tennessee Green Star Partnership achieved some impressive metrics such as; the diversion of over 100,000 tons of materials from the landfill, saving nearly 5 million dollars in operational costs through materials reductions or energy conservation, and reducing or eliminating nearly 90 tons of hazardous waste.

We have learned a great deal about the work and dedication it takes to be a truly sustainable industry in Tennessee. The industries that have been featured have varied from manufacturers of ice cream and iron skillets to recliners and complex automotive parts. Though our partners could not be more varied and different, commitment to the goal of a sustainable Tennessee has been the same in every company featured.
