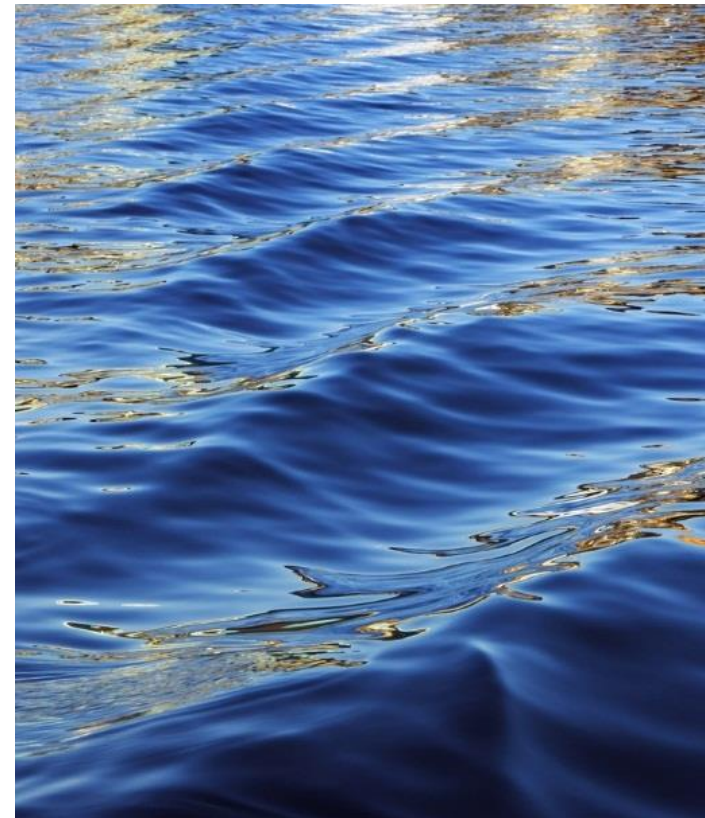

Duck River – Drought Management Recommendations

1. DRA to revise the Duck River Regional Drought Management Plan
2. Incorporate Comprehensive Drought Monitoring Analysis

Duck River – General Recommendations

1. DRA to develop a Duck River Watershed Dashboard
2. DRA to update the Duck River Comprehensive Regional Water Supply Plan
3. DRA to developing on-going partnership with all stakeholders

State-wide Recommendations

1. Create a state-wide Water Monitoring Council
2. Update TDEC's rules for drought management plans state-wide
