## Who should attend?

This course is intended for individuals who are currently working toward obtaining a certification in Distribution Systems and has failed the Grade 1 or 2 Operator Certification Exam twice.

## Prerequisite

Two failed Grade 1 or 2 Operator Examination attempts

## Course Description

This course will examine distribution system facilities and the procedures used to operate a water distribution system. The student will refamiliarize themselves with the distribution system and have the opportunity to focus on content areas that were unsuccessful on the certification examination.

- Valves and Pumps
- Fire Hydrants
- Services and Meters
- Water Storage
- Cross Connection Control
- Safety, Rules, and Recordkeeping
