



Course #201 Introduction to Wastewater Treatment



Week 1 & 2

This course is an introduction to the wastewater treatment process. The student will gain an understanding of the various components and processes used to operate a wastewater treatment facility and become familiar with State of Tennessee regulations applied to wastewater systems. A student study guide will be provided at the beginning of class. The students will also tour a wastewater treatment plant each week

It is intended for individuals who are currently working toward obtaining a certification in wastewater treatment and for certified wastewater treatment operators who want to have a better understanding of wastewater processes.
