



# Course #202 Advanced Wastewater Treatment

This course provides a more in-depth assessment of activated sludge and covers other areas of wastewater treatment processes. It is designed to expand upon the knowledge gained during Introduction to Wastewater Treatment Week 1 & 2. The students will also tour a wastewater treatment plant. A student study guide will be provided at the beginning of class.

It is intended for individuals who are currently working toward obtaining a certification in wastewater treatment and for certified wastewater treatment operators who want to have a better understanding of wastewater processes. **There** is a prerequisite of attending an Introduction to Wastewater Treatment class.
