Wastewater Treatment Board Sanctioned Training

This course will examine wastewater treatment facilities and the procedures used to operate a wastewater treatment plant. The student will refamiliarize themselves with wastewater treatment theories and have the opportunity to focus on content areas that were unsuccessful on the certification examination. A student study guide will be provided at the beginning of class.

It is intended for individuals who are currently working toward obtaining a certification in wastewater treatment and has failed any grade of the operator certification exam twice. **There is a prerequisite of two failed exam attempts.**
