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<b>NRS16.099-21</b>	<b>Applicant:</b> ADM Grain Company <b>Activity:</b> Hydraulic dredge area about 300' x 35' maximum depth of about 7'. Dredged material to be pumped to and deposited within a contained dredged material disposal site on Treasure Island nearby.

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<b>NRS20.320</b>	<b>Applicant:</b> Metropolitan Nashville Airport Authority <b>Activity:</b> The Metropolitan Nashville Airport Authority proposes to encapsulate 1,627 feet of an unnamed tributary to Sims Branch, resulting in greater than de minimis degradation to habitat of a stream segment and wetland designated as Exceptional Tennessee Waters (ETWs). 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<b>NRS21.149</b>	<b>Applicant:</b> West TN River Basin Authority <b>Activity:</b> The West Tennessee River Basin Authority proposes to relocate and restore approximately 14,500 feet of Cub Creek canal to a more natural stream of approximately 20,500 feet and restore approximately 11.7 acres of riverine wetland within the riparian areas of Cub Creek and its tributaries. This work is associated with the development of the Cub Creek Stream and Wetland Mitigation Bank, which is under review by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and the Tennessee Interagency Review Team.

**Applicant:** Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT)

Approximately 9,644 linear feet of stream will return to a naturally flowing river system, generating up to 2,608 functional feet credits at the end of a five-year monitoring period.

**Activity:** The Consolidated Utility District of Rutherford County proposes temporary impacts to 0.146 acres of wetland, Overall Creek, and a tributary to Overall Creek for the installation of 16-inch and 12-inch ductile iron water line via open-trench cut near Kingwood Lane and Windrow Drive. These temporary impacts in the Stones River watershed will be restored to pre-existing conditions.
