NRS20.023-25 Applicant: Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT)

Activity: Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) proposed to expand ITS

SMARTWAY system to include 18 CCTV cameras, 8 DMS, and 4RWIS, total proposed length of roadway construction and improvements equals 38.09 miles.

Crossing/ impacting multiple streams and wetlands.

Activity: The Tennessee Department of Transportation proposed impacts to six streams,

five wetlands, and three ponds associated with widening State Route 14 (Austin Peay Highway) in Shelby County. Loss of 422.8 functional feet (ff) of stream will be offset through purchase of credits from Rossville Farm Mitigation Bank and loss of 110.8 ff will be offset onsite through Natural Channel Design. Wetland impacts (4.445 acres) and pond impacts (1.57 acres) will be offset through credit purchases at the Loosahatchie Wetland Mitigation Bank.

of 6.22 credits from the Madison County Mitigation Bank.
