	Activity:	The Tennessee Department of Transportation proposed permanent impacts to the Wolf River, Fletcher Creek, an unnamed tributary to the Wolf River, and two wetlands for widening State Route 1 in Shelby County. The impacts involve encapsulation, fill and replacement with new channel, stream length loss, wetland fill, rip rap, and buffer zone stabilization on 1,351 feet of stream. Stream impacts will be offset by permittee responsible mitigation and 1.28 acres of wetland impacts will be offset through the purchase of 2.56 credits at Mt. Tena Wetland Mitigation Bank.

	Activity:	East Tennessee Natural Gas, LLC proposed temporary impacts to approximately 29.28 acres of wetland, 37,831 feet of stream, 8.18 acres of jurisdictional pond, 0.12 acres of permanent wetland fill, 4.67 acres of temporary wetland vegetation type conversion, 0.68 acres of permanent wetland type conversion, and permanent impacts to 2,210 feet of stream. Impacts across eight counties are associated with the construction of a 118-mile, 30-inch diameter pipeline and an approximately 4-mile, 30-inch diameter header pipeline (Mainline), an electric		

powered compressor station, a solar power generation facility, installation of two new and the modification of two existing metering and regulating stations, and the removal of approximately 24 miles of existing abandoned in place pipeline.
