### **State Revolving Fund (SRF) Loan Applicants and Interested Parties**

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) will hold a public meeting to present the Draft Intended Use Plans (IUPs) for:

- FFY26/SFY27 Clean Water State Revolving Funding (CWSRF),
- FFY26/SFY27 Drinking Water State Revolving Funding (DWSRF),
- FFY25/SFY26 Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Lead Service Line Replacement Funding (DWSRF LSL),
- Clean Water Supplemental Appropriations for Hurricanes Helene and Milton and Hawai'i Wildfires (CWSRF SA-HMW),
  - Including the CWSRF SA-HMW Decentralized Systems Capitalization Grant, and
- Drinking Water Supplemental Appropriations for Hurricanes Helene and Milton and Hawai'i Wildfires (DWSRF SA-HMW).

These documents will be open for public comment and available on the [SRF website](#) by May 5, 2026.

Intended Use Plans explain how the program intends to use the associated capitalization grant dollars. Each IUP includes a Priority Ranking List (PRL) of eligible projects who have applied for funding. The draft IUPs will be finalized after a 30-day public comment period.
