Notice of Individual Permit Decisions

This serves as notice of the division's decisions on Aquatic Resource Alteration Permit or §401 Water Quality Certification applications previously posted for public comment. Publication of this notice serves as commencement of the thirty-day period for appeal by third parties pursuant to TCA 69-3-105(i). NRS25.090 Applicant: Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT)
Activity: Tennessee Department of Transportation proposed newly authorized work includes 200 feet of additional temporary impacts. The purpose of the modification is for additional debris removal that is hazardous to the public. Previously authorized work consists of emergency replacement of SR-353 bridge over the Nolichucky River. Unavoidable permanent impacts to 90 feet of stream for the construction of a new 480-foot long by 36-foot-wide bridge with concrete abutments and riprap.

NRS25.198 Applicant: MRW Environmental LLC
Activity: MRW Environmental LLC proposed the restoration (reestablishment and rehabilitation) of 55+/- acres of self-sustaining forested headwater slope wetland (HSW) and restoration of 5,442.19 +/- linear feet of four streams. Based on the existing conditions of the Bank, approximately 5.15 acres of wetland, 50.36 acres of farmed wetlands, and 4,555.27 linear feet of stream are present within the Bank property. Historical disturbances to the parcel and in the local watershed have caused widespread stream and wetland degradation. The majority of the parcels are an agricultural field, and all streams have been straightened, channelized, severely impacted, and offset from their historic positions. The Bank aims to improve several function-based parameters by meeting the objectives identified in Table 1. For function-based parameters where the existing streams are currently functioning, the Bank will maintain this rating.

Activity: HGS, LLC proposed the reissuance of permit NRS20.189, which involves
varying stream mitigation treatments along 13,246 linear feet of stream and 45.45
acres of wetland within the riparian buffer for the Lodi Mitigation Bank in
Athens, McMinn County.

NRS26.008 Applicant: Aquatic Weed Wizards
Activity: Aquatic Weed Wizards proposed maintenance dredging of a private pond via
mechanical dredging. A maximum of 1,000 cubic yards of silt and organic
material will be removed from the ponds and placed in on-site upland locations
near each pond for dewatering. The project also includes replacement of a
damaged overflow pipe within the dam structure of the pond.
