Notice of Individual Permit Decisions

July 31, 2026

This serves as notice of the division's decisions on Aquatic Resource Alteration Permit or §401 Water Quality Certification applications previously posted for public comment. Publication of this notice serves as commencement of the thirty-day period for appeal by third parties pursuant to TCA 69-3-105(i). NRS21.024-26 Applicant: Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT)
Activity: The Tennessee Department of Transportation proposed impacts to nine tributaries to the Rutherford Fork Obion River and three wetlands associated with widening and realignment of State Route 76 near Atwood in Carroll and Gibson Counties. The 0.689 acres of wetland impacts are to be offset through purchase of 1.38 wetland mitigation credits from the Obion Wetland Mitigation Bank. Stream impacts total a loss of 438.4 functional feet and will be offset through 458 potential functional-feet credits to be generated through on-site Permittee Responsible Mitigation by stream relocations with functional lift.

NRS25.032 Applicant: Randy Jones
Activity: Randy Jones proposed a total of 405 linear feet of stream impact to four Misc Tribs to East Camp Creek and 0.354 acres of permanent wetland fill to four unnamed wetlands for the construction of roadway crossings and utility line crossings for residential development. All roadway crossings consist of 2-foot-tall by 5-foot-wide bottomless (3-sided) box culverts and concrete headwalls at all inlets and outlets. Utility lines crossings include sewer and water lines, installed via open cut trenching at the road crossing locations. Permanent stream impacts will be mitigated through the purchase of 146.4 stream credits from Little Trammel Creek Stream Mitigation Bank and 0.99 wetland credits from Tennessee Mitigation Fund.

Impacts will be compensated through purchase of 102.7 functional foot credits from Little Trammel Creek Stream Mitigation Bank.

	Activity:	Tennessee Department of Transportation proposed improved access to the Packaging Corporation of America along SR-57 by constructing a new 0.30-mile standard State Industrial Access (SIA). A crossing/impact of one (1) stream including installation of a box culvert at 3:1 side slopes at the crossing, resulting in 14.75 feet of stream length loss requiring 7.2 functional foot mitigation. Stream length loss mitigation proposed to be fulfilled through the Center Point Stream Mitigation Bank. Temporary stream crossing (Temporary Culvert Crossing) during construction located within right-of-way easements, not to exceed one temporary stream crossing per impact location and Temporary Diversion Channel to divert normal stream flow.

Temporary impacts include a haul road, culverts, and work pads in the channel.

	Activity:	Center Point Investments proposed the continued monitoring of Center Point Mitigation Bank in the Middleton Creek Watershed in Chester County. The proposed impacts include varying stream mitigation treatments including restoration, enhancement, creation, and preservation along approximately 23,250.50 linear feet of stream and wet weather conveyance.

Stream impacts will be compensated through on-site permittee responsible mitigation and purchase of 83.5 functional-foot stream credits from the Cumberland River Compact Upper Cumberland Service Area. Wetland impacts will be compensated through the purchase of 1.752 credits from the Harpeth River Wetland Mitigation Bank.
