DR. LIANE B. RUSSELL

For more than 40 years, Dr. Liane B. Russell has been working to preserve and protect Tennessee's rivers and parks. Liane and her husband, Bill (for whom the Raven Hero Award is named) organized Tennessee Citizens for Environmental Business Planning and were instrumental in creating the Obed River and the Big South Fork of the Cumberland River. Liane played a key role in the drafting and passage of the State Scenic Rivers Act, the first such act in the United States.



Through her work, more than 150,000 acres of land and more than 120 miles of river are permanently protected from adverse development in the Cumberlandlands. Because of her efforts against siltation and drainage, many of Tennessee's rivers are spared siltation and degradation. Throughout Tennessee and in her hometown, she has helped protect lands and water to make them available for generations to come.
