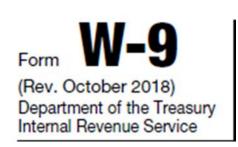

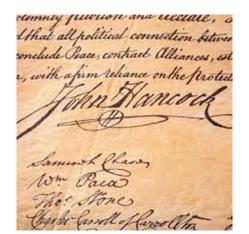

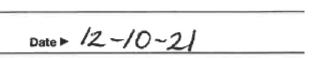


General W-9 requirements

- Legible
- Not altered
- Completed according to IRS W-9 instructions
- Most recent version (Rev. Oct. 2018)
- Hand-signed (electronic signatures are not accepted)
- Complete address (includes address suffix)
- EIN or SSN (cannot list both)
- Dated within one year of date of submission









Common W-9 Obstacles







TIN Match

- Before information can be updated in Edison, the Supplier Name (line 1 of W-9) and TIN (Tax ID Number) combination must pass the IRS TIN Match
- We receive the results as either a pass or fail



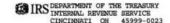






TIN Match

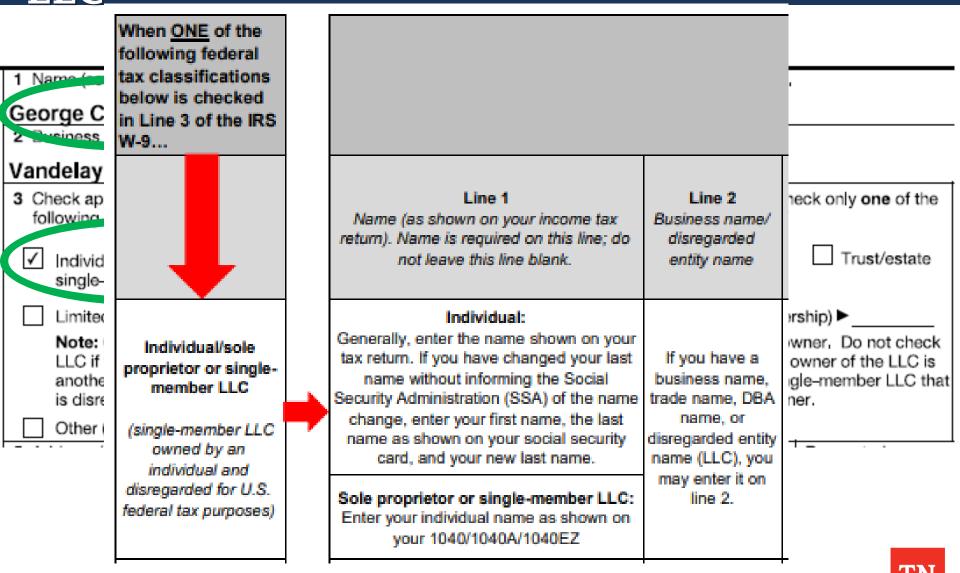

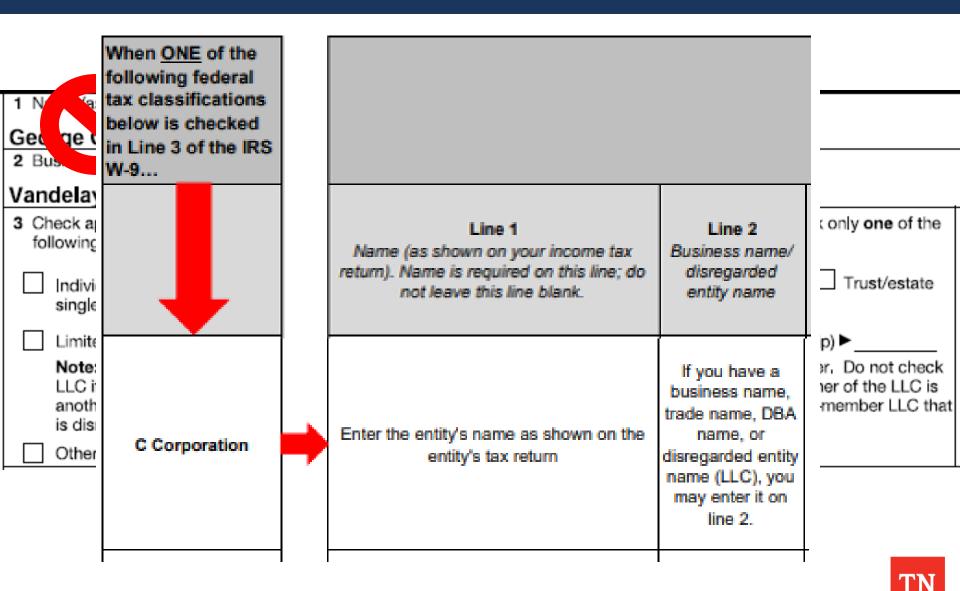

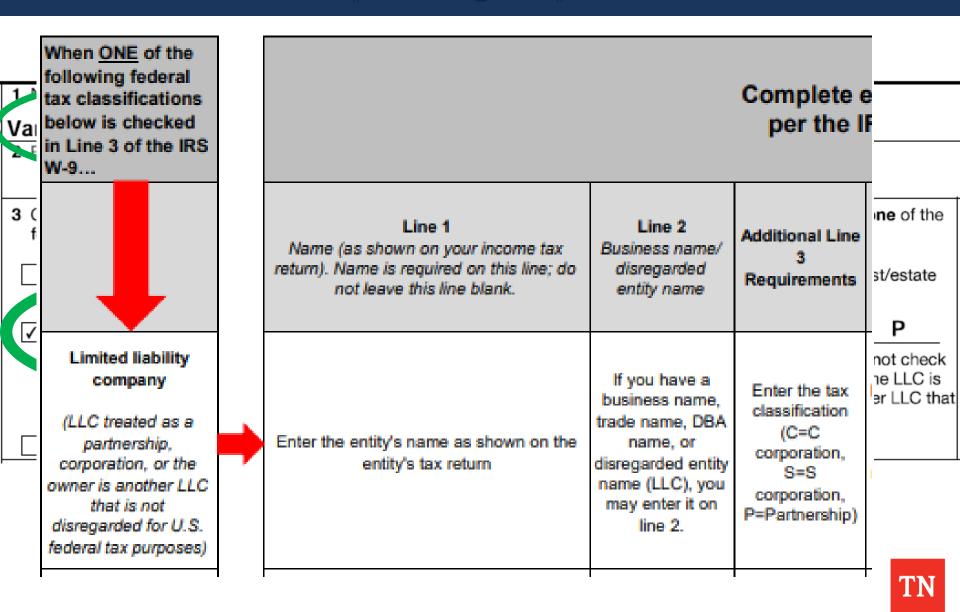
