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At 12:06 Emily Gibson, STS, gave a brief overview of all current ISC policies as per annual requirement. Gibson shared a PowerPoint presentation, links to all ISC policies online, and answered accompanying questions from ISC members.

At 12:12PM a quorum was achieved with the arrival of an ISC member.

At 12:18PM Gibson then introduced Gabrielle Authier, STS Executive Director, who presented ISC Policy 5: IS Mgmt. and Systems Development Lifecycle. Authier gave an overview of the policy, explaining that the policy had been thoroughly reviewed by STS and ISC staff, and at this time no recommended changes were presented. Following questions and discussion, ISC members voted to approve Policy 5 as written at 12:26PM (Motioned: Yarbro, Seconded: Tate).

At 12:27PM Gibson introduced Andrew Spragg, STS Deputy CISO, who presented ISC Policy 9: Disaster Recovery. Spragg presented an overview of the policy, explaining that this policy had also had no recommended changes following STS and ISC staff review. Following questions and discussion, ISC members voted to approve Policy 9 as written at 12:31PM (Motioned: Bell, Seconded: Tate).

At 12:28PM, Stephanie Dedmon opened the floor for a motion to approve the April 8th, 2021 ISC minutes as drafted. A motion was made by Bell, seconded by Yarbro, and approved by all members present.

Stephanie Dedmon gave closing remarks at 12:39PM, thanking ISC members and staff for their participation. The meeting was adjourned at 12:40PM.
