When you use an Optum® SUD Preferred Provider for inpatient, residential or outpatient treatment services, your costs will be waived, as part of your State of Tennessee behavioral health benefits. PPO members who use these high-quality facilities, will not pay a deductible or co-insurance. CDHP/HSA members co-insurance will be waived after meeting their deductible.

Prior authorization is required for in-network and out-of-network services. If a prior authorization is not received, claims for services may be denied for reimbursement.

These include medication assisted treatment with behavioral support services and counseling. However, each person is unique, so it is important that you have a treatment plan that is designed specifically for you.
