

Tobacco Quit Aids

The state's prescription drug coverage provides free tobacco quit aids to members who want to stop using tobacco products.

The following quit aids are **FREE** under the pharmacy benefit:

- Chantix and its generic, Varenicline
- Bupropion (generic Zyban)
- Over-the-counter **generic** nicotine replacement products, including gum, patches and lozenges
- Nicotrol oral and nasal inhalers

Members may receive up to two, 12-week courses of treatment per calendar year (up to 168 days of treatment) with no lifetime maximum.

For members to obtain over-the-counter products at no cost, a prescription from their doctor is required. Quit aid prescriptions for 30-day supplies can be filled at participating network pharmacies, while 90-day supplies can be obtained at participating 90-day retail pharmacies or through Caremark mail order.
