World Elder Abuse Awareness Day, observed June 15th each year, helps raise awareness and promote a better understanding of the types of abuse, neglect, or financial exploitation associated with elder adults. For information on elder abuse, click on the video below.



Fast Facts:

- From 2002-2016, about 1 in 10 (age 60 or older) living at home experienced abuse, including neglect and exploitation; elder abuse is presumed to be significantly underreported. (CDC)
- In 2022, adults over age 60 lost \$70 million to lottery/sweepstakes/inheritance
 scams and \$1.1 billion to scams related to cryptocurrency. Tennessee Data (FBI IC3)
