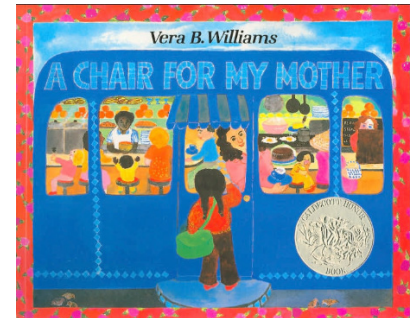


Suggested Reading List
