The Town of Collierville, an Equal Opportunity, Affirmative Action Employer, is requesting sealed bids for the Town's grant funded Shelton Road Oxidation Ditch Rotor Replacement. The work consists of supplying all materials and labor for the direct replacement, including installation and leveling, of two oxidation ditch rotors. Both rotors are located at the Shelton Road Wastewater Treatment Plant, 136 E. Shelton Road, Collierville, TN. Certain restrictions and other federal requirements apply to this opportunity as it is administered through the Tennessee Department of Environmental and Conservation (TDEC) – Division of Water Resources (DWR) - American Rescue Plan (ARP) State Water Infrastructure Grants (SWIG) Program.

A non-mandatory, on-site pre-bid conference is scheduled for Tuesday, April 23, 2024. Bids to be received at Town Hall Board Chambers located at 500 Poplar View Parkway, 38017 until 2:00:00 P.M CST on May 1, 2024. The bid award date is tentatively scheduled for May 13, 2024.
