### **Questions received to-date:**

- Q1. Does entire project manual need to be submitted with the bid?
- A1. No, just the bid form, bid bond (with power of attorney), and certifications
- Q2. Do you know the locations and depths of the waterline? We saw 2 hydrants on site.
- A2. There is an active shallow water line from Walnut Street that serves the 2 hydrants in the park. The contractor will need to coordinate with Grand Junction Public Works to locate the line and adjust as necessary prior to trail construction. Contact is Public Works Director Ransom Crenshaw at 731-394-6889.
- Q3. Will tree pruning be allowed? Some limbs could be in the way of equipment access.
- A3. Yes. Pruning activities and methods must be coordinated and approved by the City.
- Q4. Would soil cement be considered as alternative to Crushed Stone? Dirt calculations may not benefit from this.
- A4. No the preference will be to use gravel base as shown in plans.
- Q5. Typical Section has Crushed Stone the same width as Asphalt. The Stone Base needs to extend out a minimum of 6" beyond the Asphalt to give a solid base for compaction or else the asphalt could just break/fall off the edge when compacted.
- A5. It is acceptable extend gravel base to ensure trail stability.
